



20th Avenue Rehabilitation

The Town of Didsbury would like to inform you of the 20th Avenue Rehabilitation project which is set to begin on Wednesday April 26th 2017. This project is projected to be completed at the end of July and will have various workers and lane closures in the area. The project is broke down into the following components:

- Project begins with the removal of the concrete sidewalks and will progress from 14th Street west to 19th Street one block at a time.
- When all concrete replacement has been completed, 20th Avenue will have the asphalt milled out and repaved. 20th Avenue from 14th Street to 19th Street will be closed during this milling & paving work and detours will be in place.
- Concrete street light bases, and eventually new street lights, will be installed alternating on both sides of 20th avenue. This may mean that a street light is placed in a location that was not previously utilized. The Town has directed the contractor to ensure that impact to residential lawns and gardens is minimized. Further, these street lights will only be placed on Town property and will not encroach onto landowner's property lines.
- The milling and paving is expected for a week at the end of July, subject to weather conditions.

Some important notes for you:

- Garbage collection will occur as usual. In the event that you are unable to have the bin placed on your road due to the construction, please leave the bin(s) at the end of your yard and our contractor will handle the disposal of it.
- There may be times when your driveway is inaccessible due to excavation or fresh pouring of concrete or asphalt. We appreciate your patience and consideration during these times.
- We hope to keep 20th avenue as open and accessible as possible throughout the project, however there may be various detours and road closures needed during the course of the construction.
